Biographical Sketch:

Glenn Richard Goss was born March 6, 1932, in Columbia, PA. He graduated from Penn State University and earned his ThM in 1958 and ThD in 1966 from Dallas Theological Seminary. He married Doris Millet, and they had two sons. He was a professor at Dallas Bible College, Calvary Bible College in Kansas City, MO, and Philadelphia Biblical University [later renamed Cairn University]. Glenn R. Goss served as a consultant on *The New Scofield Study Bible NAS* published in 1988. Dr. Goss died on November 18, 2010.

The Glenn R. Goss Papers are arranged in two series:

Series I. Scofield Reference Bible of 1909, 2001-2005 and undated, .17 linear ft. (2 folders).

Arranged by printing and inventory number.

Series II. New Testament, American Standard Version, undated, .14 linear ft. (2 folders).

Arranged by page number.

Scope and Content Note:

About half of the collection is information Glenn Goss collected about different printings of the 1909 Scofield Reference Bible and the other half is a loose-leaf *New Testament* with typed and handwritten marginal notes. The papers are in four folders in one gray document box.

The collection is divided into two series: *Scofield Reference Bible* of 1909 and *New Testament, American Standard Version*. Dr. Goss identified five printings of the 1909 edition of the *Scofield Reference Bible* with various changes before it was officially revised in 1917. Goss collected information from several libraries and some individuals who owned a 1909 *Scofield Reference Bible*. He also recorded some information about the Spanish and Russian translations. The New Testament ASV has marginalia.
