Biographical Sketch: Kenneth Frank Horton earned his B.A. from Auburn University in 1973. He completed his ThM in 1981 and his PhD in 1999, both at Dallas Theological Seminary. He was senior pastor of McKinney Memorial Bible Church from 1988-2011. He now serves through Ministry Catalysts in Fort Worth, TX.

Historical Sketch: The Vineyard Movement began in California in the 1970s. John Wimber became the leader in the 1980s. Upon Wimber's death in 1997, Todd Hunter took charge. In his dissertation, Horton outlined three phases of the Vineyard Movement. Originally Vineyard churches emphasized healing and other spiritual gifts (1977-1988), later focused on an end-time revival (1989-1992), and then on individual renewal (1993-1996).
